Maintaining your Bella Turf artificial grass.

One of the more attractive selling features of artificial grass is that it requires minimal maintenance. Like any other exterior surface, it still needs a cleaning. Dust, pollen, leaves and other debris can make its way into your turf. A monthly cleaning will keep your yard looking fresher for longer. For a light clean up, take a leaf rake or stiff bristle push broom to remove any debris from the surface. If there are pine needles embedded in the turf or the blades need a revitalization, we recommend using a power broom. Once the surface is clear, use the hose and rinse any remaining debris off of the grass blades. If there is an unpleasant odour to your grass, we recommend using TurfRenu to rinse away any unwanted smell and have your yard smelling as fresh as it looks.

To keep your new Bella Turf installation looking its best, we recommend that you give it a general maintenance on a regular basis. If you remove organic debris like leaves, seeds and needles from your grass, they will not have a chance to compost and lead to growth of moss and weeds. If your grass is covered in leaves, it is recommended to clean it off before any activity that could cause the leaves to break down and make their way into your turf.

Although your grass will be green all year long, it is recommended to prepare for the seasonal weather. Debris on the surface is much easier to pick up and clean off before the rain comes. The quickest and simplest way to do so would be to use a leaf blower and blow them into a pile, usually in the corner, for an easy cleanup. If you do not have access to a leaf blower, a simple leaf rake will do the job.

If you see weeds popping up in your grass, no need to worry. Most of these are small seedlings that have germinated in the infill. Simply take a small screwdriver and wiggle it around next to the weed. In most cases it will pull right out as the roots are unable to attach themselves firmly.

If you have large children's toys (playhouses, slides, pools, etc.) on the grass or even heavy pots for your plants, these can be rearranged without harming the grass beneath. When you move them off, simply brush the blades back up with a stiff bristle broom and the turf will return to its original beauty. Never again will you have to worry about "dead spots" from your grass not seeing the sun.

Cleaning up after your pets has never been easier. We recommend an everyday spade shovel for any easy removal of even the biggest of droppings. Line it up, put some downward pressure so the blades lean over and with a swift scoop, all gone! No holes or bare spots left in the grass from the shovel and if there happens to be any remaining mess, give it a quick spray with the hose and your grass is clean again. For a full yard refresh, pick up a bottle of TurfRenu and remove any and all unwanted odours.

The hot weather will not harm your grass, but fire and ash will. Your grass might look lush and green, but in no case should you ever allow hot items like barbecue ashes or cigarettes to come in contact with the turf. You will create melted spots on your grass and these are very difficult to hide.

Forget the mower and save yourself time and water throughout the summer with your new Bella Turf yard. Take a few moments to keep the surface clean just as you would the floor in your home and you will have a beautiful lawn for years to come.
